



## Jesus calms a big storm

(Mark 4:35-41)

<sup>35</sup> One evening Jesus said to his followers,  
“Come with me in the boat across the lake.” <sup>36</sup>  
So they left all the crowds behind and got into  
the boat. <sup>37</sup> A big wind began to blow, and the  
waves were so big that the boat began to fill  
with water. <sup>38</sup> Jesus was at the back of the boat

<sup>39</sup> Jesus stood up and gave orders to the wind  
and the waves. He said, “Quiet! Stop!”

<sup>41</sup> The followers were really scared now and
