



Day 1: Water into Wine: Someone to be watched...

*John 2: 1-11*

Once Jesus, his mother and his followers were invited to a wedding in a place called Cana near the Sea of Galilee.

Right in the middle of the wedding disaster struck – they ran out of wine! Mary, Jesus' mum told Jesus about the problem. Jesus said that the time when people would see his glory on full display had not come yet. Mary told those serving at the wedding to do whatever Jesus told them to do.

Not far away were six large water containers used for washing which each held 100 litres (larger than a dustbin) of water. Jesus told the servants to fill them with water right to the top. Then he said, "Take some out and give it to the man who organised the wedding banquet."

When the man tasted it, the water had turned into wine (but at this point he didn't know that it had been water and that a miracle had taken place). He spoke to the bridegroom and said, "It's normal to save the less good wine to the end of the celebration but you have saved the very best wine until last!"

This was the first miracle Jesus did, and people saw how special he was. His followers saw how amazing Jesus was and realised they could really trust him.
