GROUP 4:

When the followers stepped out of the boat and onto the shore, they saw a fire of hot coals. There fish on the fire, and there was bread. Then Jesus said, 'Bring some of the fish that you caught.'

GROUP 5:

You will need

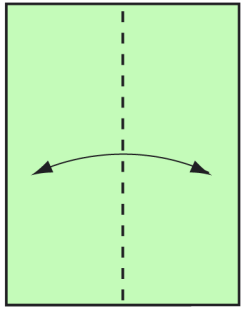
- paper plate

- ribbon



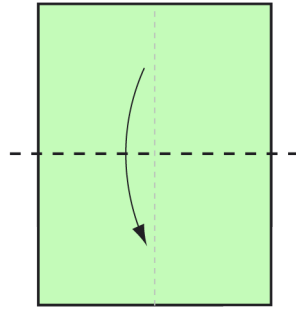
1. Cut out a triangle in the paper plate.

Origami Boat

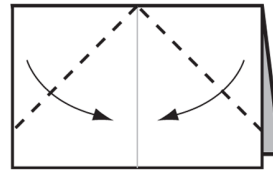
STEP 01: Start with a rectangular piece of paper colour side up. Fold in half and open.



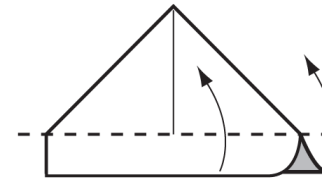
STEP 02: Fold down the other half.



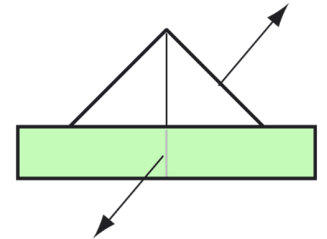
STEP 03: Bring corners in to the centre line.



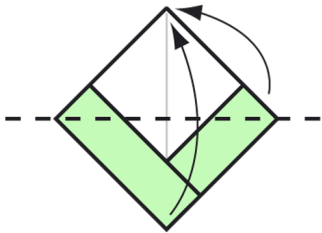
STEP 04: Fold uppermost layer upwards and do the same to the back. Crease well.



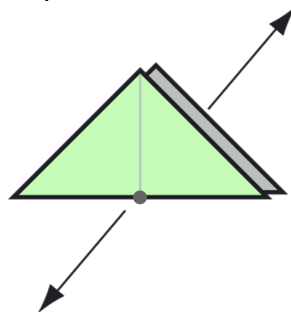
STEP 05: Pull the sides out and flatten.



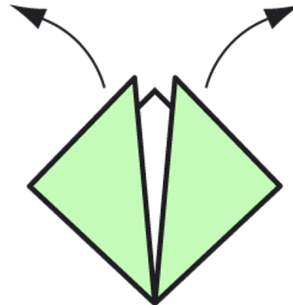
STEP 06: Fold front layer up to top, then do the same at the back.



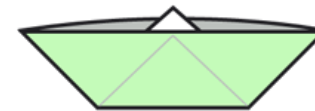
STEP 07: Pull the undersides apart and flatten into a square shape.



STEP 08: Gently pull the top parts of the model outwards, making a boat shape.



STEP 09: Flatten well to crease all folds. Then open out slightly, forming a boat shape. Well done!



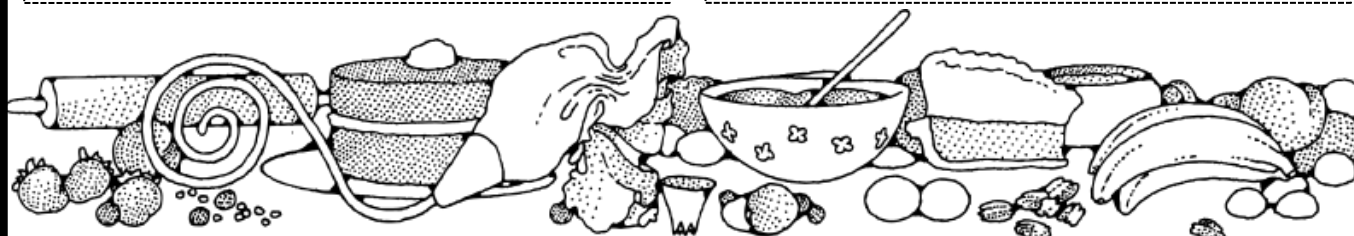

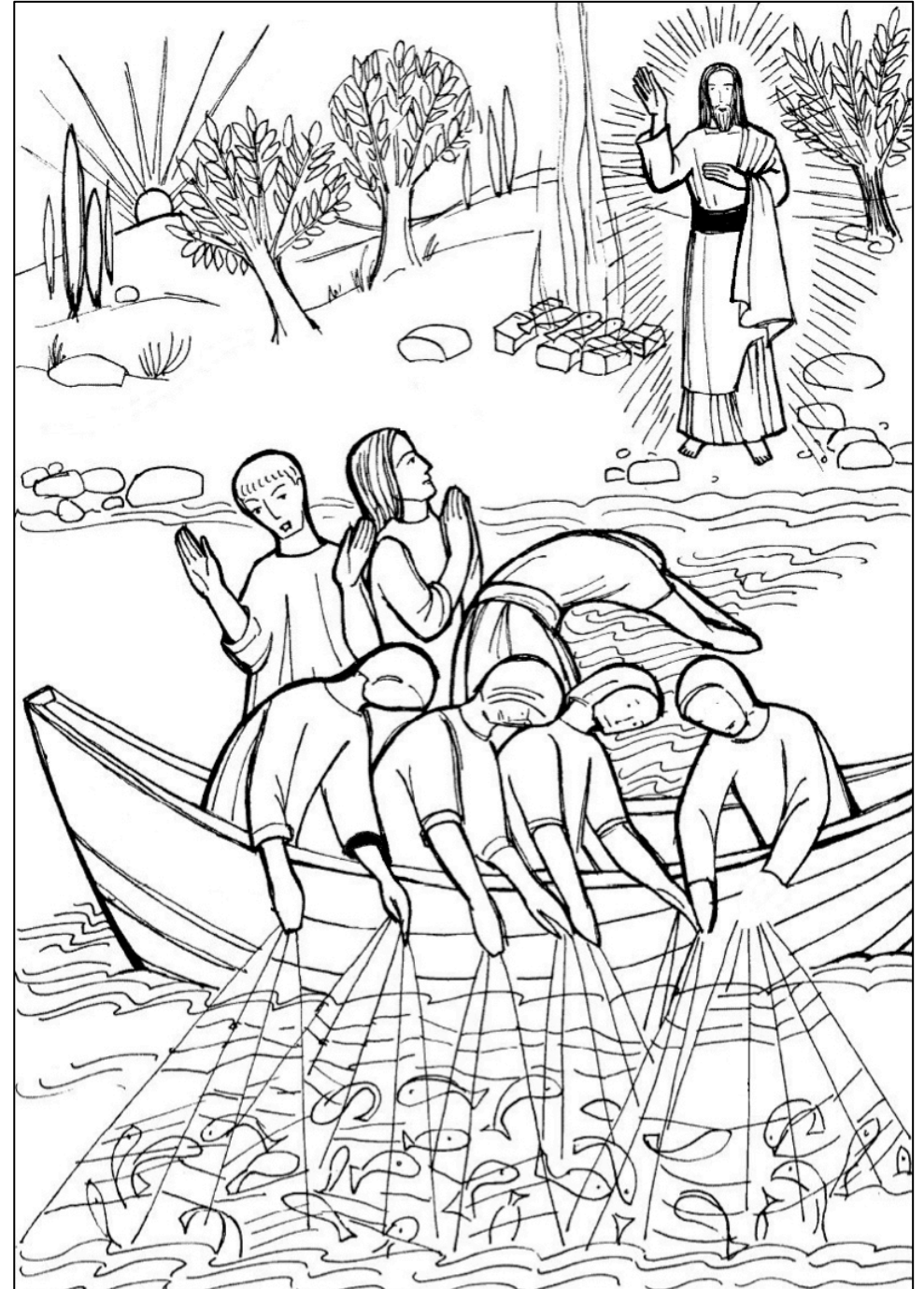
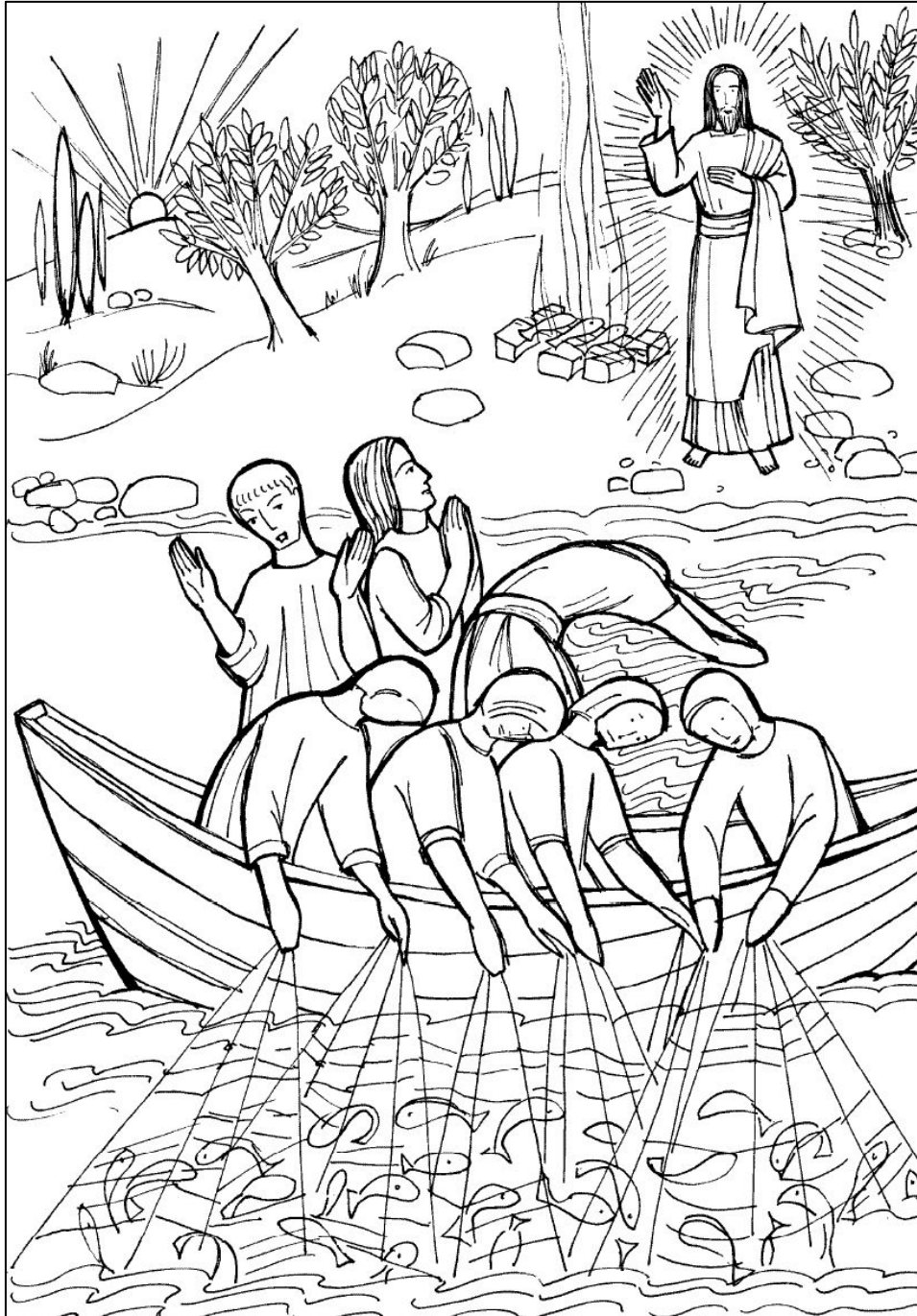
Simon Peter Board Game

Peter had had a long journey following Jesus to this point. Play this fishy game to remind you of his good and bad moment as Jesus changed him from fisherman to disciple.

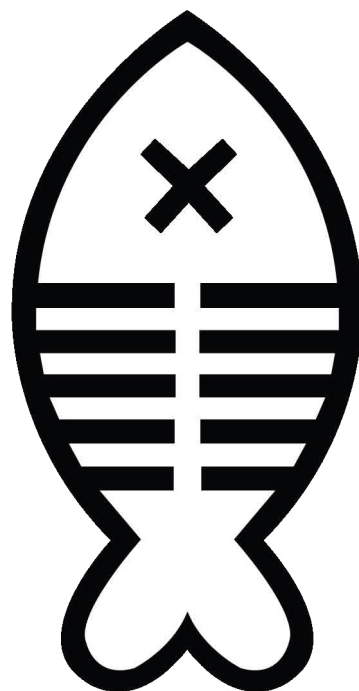
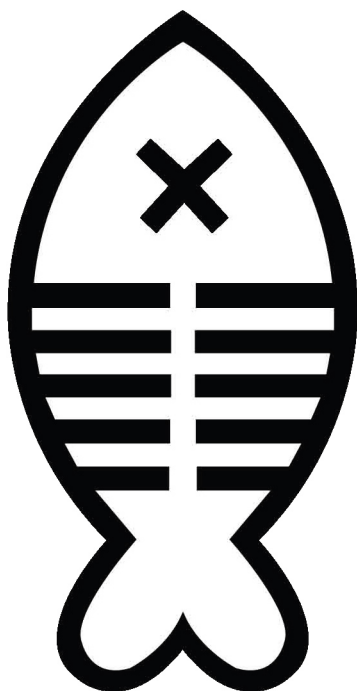
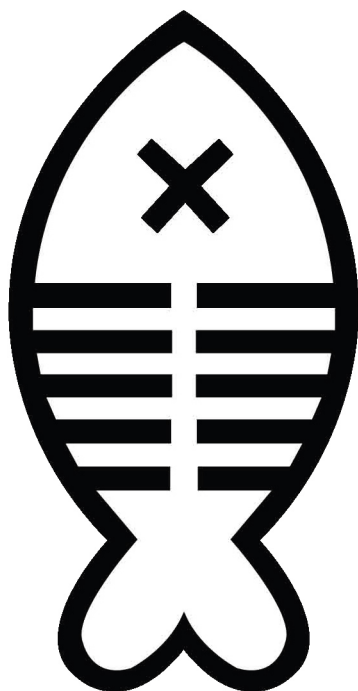
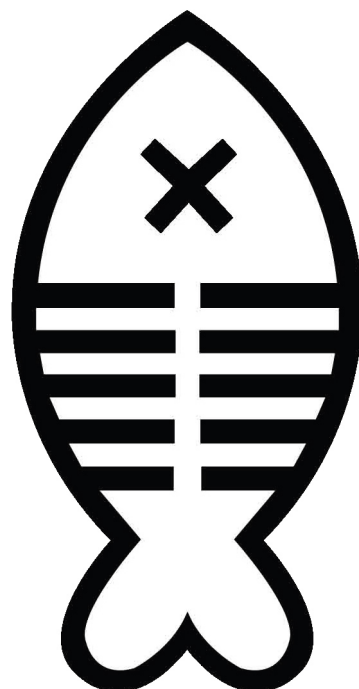
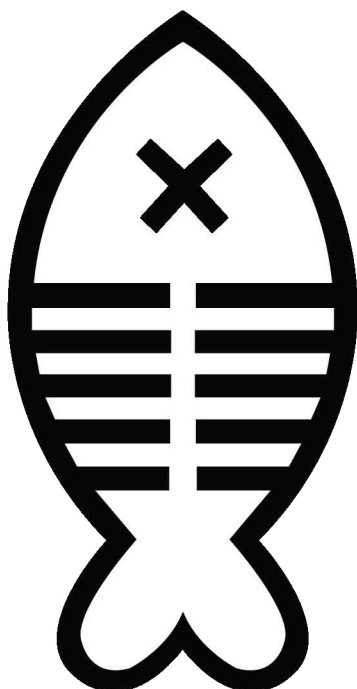
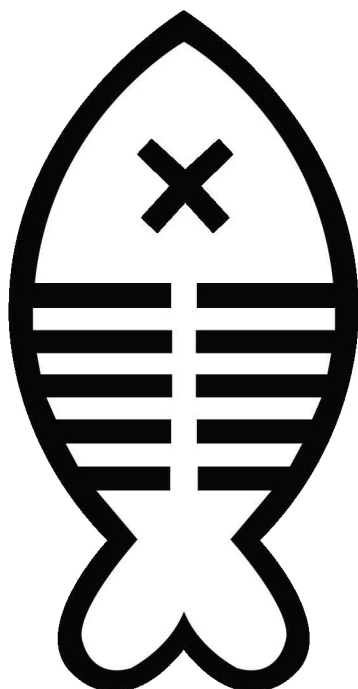
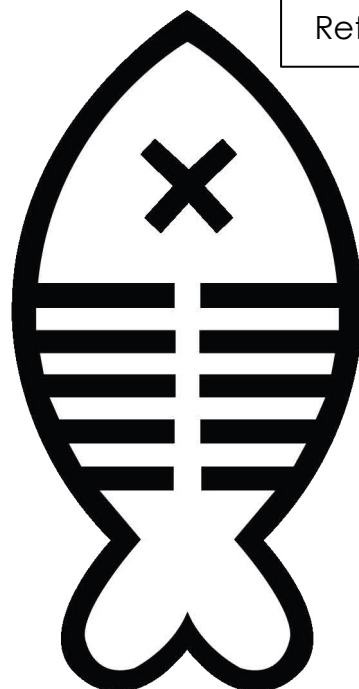


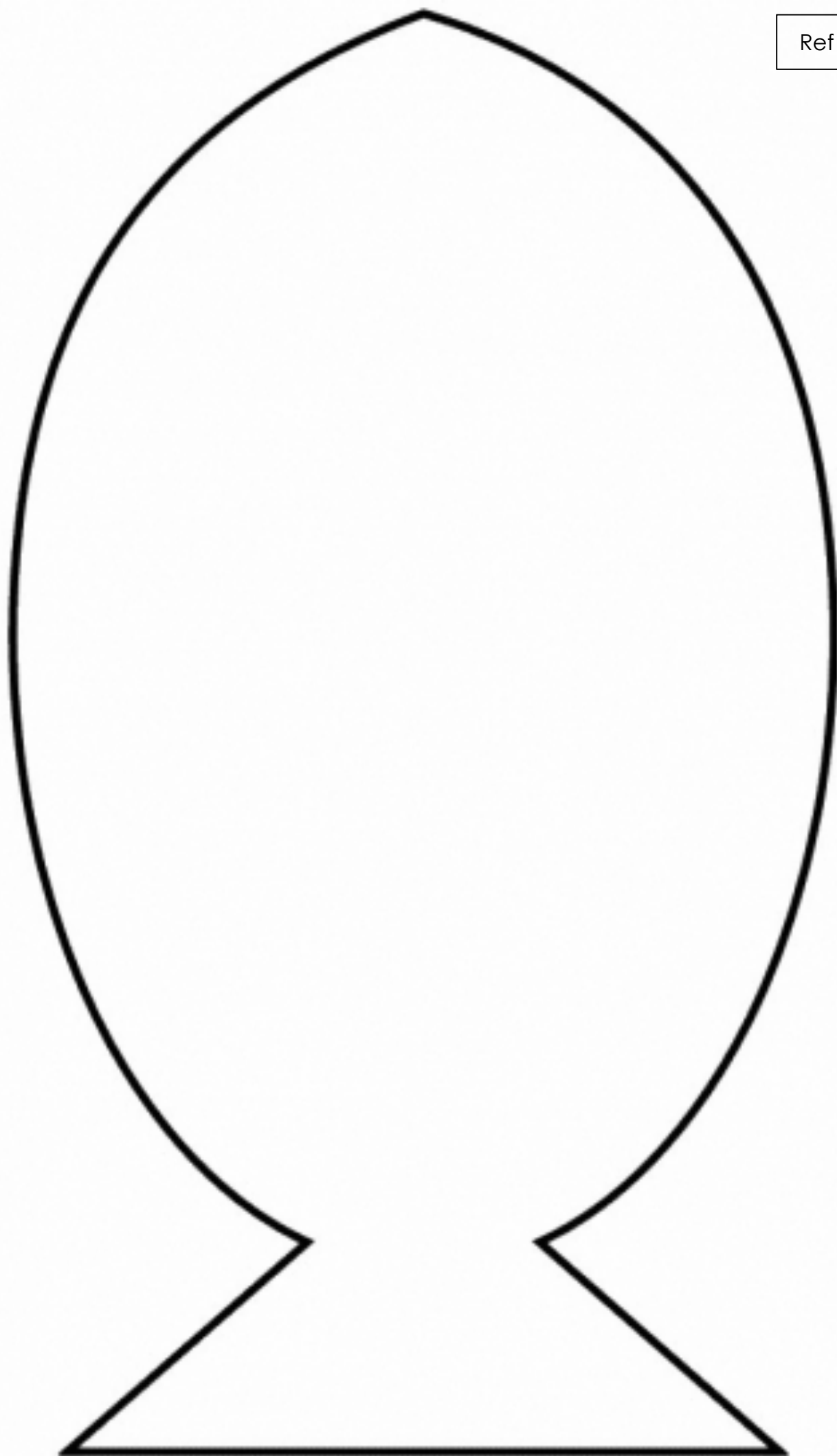
